Stephen McKenna MD says "last year multi-centre were quite popular particularly with safari and beach combo offers such as Sri Lanka and the Maldives. People are looking to mix things up and make the most of their getaway by adding different destinations to the mix. Looking at the rise in figures we are quite confident that multi-centre options will be the number one choice for travellers in 2014".

In Ireland, the local community in Limerick, hosts of the first Irish City of Culture, are determined to make it a year to remember despite a controversial start to the proceedings. Events planned include 'Riverdance' 20 years on, Irish premiere of the best selling show Fuerza Bruta, a major Choral Festival and in visual arts 'The Haselbeck Collection'.

In Northern Ireland Belfast continues to attract large numbers of Irish and overseas visitors thanks to successful attractions such as the Titanic Quarter, Crumlin Road Gaol and the MAC. Derry/Londonderry was an excellent host of UK city of Culture for 2013 where visitor numbers exceeded all expectations and events such as Fleadh Cheoil na hEireann and the Return of Colmcille brought people from all over the world.
