Newgrange in Co Meath to celebrate the winter solstice 2015. People gather from dawn at Newgrange from 18 to 23 December to watch the sunrise. All access to the chamber is decided by lottery, but everyone else is welcome to come and stand outside the monument to celebrate. Five thousand years ago, the Neolithic farmers ingeniously engineered it so that sunlight could enter the vaulted chamber at dawn on the winter solstice. On clear solstice mornings, the chamber at the end of the passage is fully illuminated and bathed in a wonderful golden glow.
