TAKE the road less travelled when it comes to the Spanish Camino and discover a whole other route along the sacred way. The Camino Primitivo (Original Way) is the oldest route, undertaken by Alfonso, the king of Asturias way back in the 9th century. Now, a six-night walk will kick off in the city of Lugo, a place with World Heritage status thanks to its claim to one of the best preserved Roman walls in the world. Prices start from €599, available year round, and covers accommodation on a halfboard basis, luggage transfers along the route and your 'pilgrim passport' documenting your walk. Flights cost extra.
